CNDH has adopted leading industry protocols to ensure the highest quality and safety standards that keep our patients, co-workers and visitors as safe as possible while on our campus.

We appreciate your patience and understanding as our response evolves and various protocols are updated on a regular basis. Ultimately, the goal is to maintain the safest environment possible for our patients and workers.

The CNDH visitation policy can be subject to change depending on the hospital census and status of COVID-19 pandemic within the Chickasaw Nation and surrounding communities.

CNDH Clinic and Hospital Visitor Policy and Visiting Hours

Visiting hours will be 8am to 10pm for all inpatient units. Visitors will need to follow any unit specific guidance while on campus. Masks required.

Visitation for COVID-19 Patients:

- No visitors while infectious except for special circumstances.
- Staff will monitor when precautions can be lifted based on CDC guidance.

For Women's Care/Gynecology patients:

• Each patient may have up to four visitors on the OB unit at one time. Children 12 years of age and younger will not be permitted on the unit

For Labor & Delivery/Postpartum patients:

• Each patient may have up to four visitors on the OB unit at one time. Children 12 years of age and younger will only be permitted on the unit if they are a sibling of the newborn.

Outpatient/Clinic: No visitation restrictions.

Visitors **should not visit** if they are experiencing any of the following:

- 1) A positive viral test for COVID-19
- 2) Symptoms of COVID-19
- 3) Close contact with someone with COVID-19 infection.
